We are going to talk about music, because we think that everybody listens to it a lot. We can listen to music by radio, computers, MP3 players...

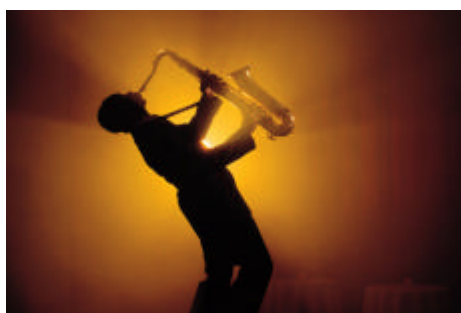
There are a lot of types of music in the world, for example:

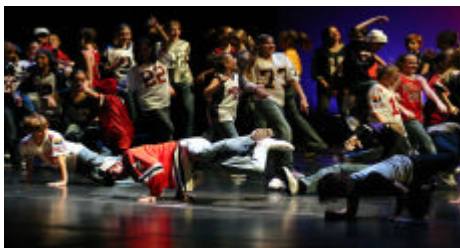
Jazz: The main important instruments of jazz music are the cornet, trumpet and the violin. It was born at the beginning of the 20th century in United States.

KURT COBAIN

You should know this artist because he is one of the best known rock artist and guitarist ever seen. He was a member of Nirvana; an alternative rock band of the eighties. He was born on the 20th of February 1967 in Aberdeen, USA.

He learned to play drums and electric guitar at the Musical Roseyear Center which is in Aberdeen. He became interested in music at an early age and his aunt once said that he usually sang The Beatles' songs like "Hey Jude".

He hated his parents for years because they got divorced when he was nine. After a year living with his mother he moved to Montesano to live with his father.



NIRVANA

Nirvana was formed by Kurt Cobain and Krist Novoselic in 1987. They published three albums: *Bleach*, *Nevermind* and *In Utero*. The band has sold over 50 million albums all over the world, including 10 million copies of *Nevermind*. They became famous with that album, the second of their career.

In 1992 they won a MTV Video Music Award for the best alternative video; in 1993 they won the Brit Award for the best new artist and they also won a Grammy for the best alternative album.

Their last album is a compilation with their best songs and videos published in 2010.



DRUGS

A drug is a biological material that is used for medicines development. A drug can also be a medicament. There are a lot of types but the most common ones are the depressant drugs that slow brain functions. The most addictive drugs are: nicotine, crack, alcohol, cocaine, heroin and ecstasy.

He wanted to get divorced from Courtney Love and get their daughter Frances Bean's custody.

Eldon Hoke was bribed by Courtney to kill Kurt and she was the first person to communicate Kurt's suicide.

The 8th of April of 1994 his corpse was found by the police on his house's garage. Many theories have emerged since this happened.

One of most incredible ones is that Courtney Love (his wife) killed him; another one



is that a guitarist killed him and other is that he committed suicide.

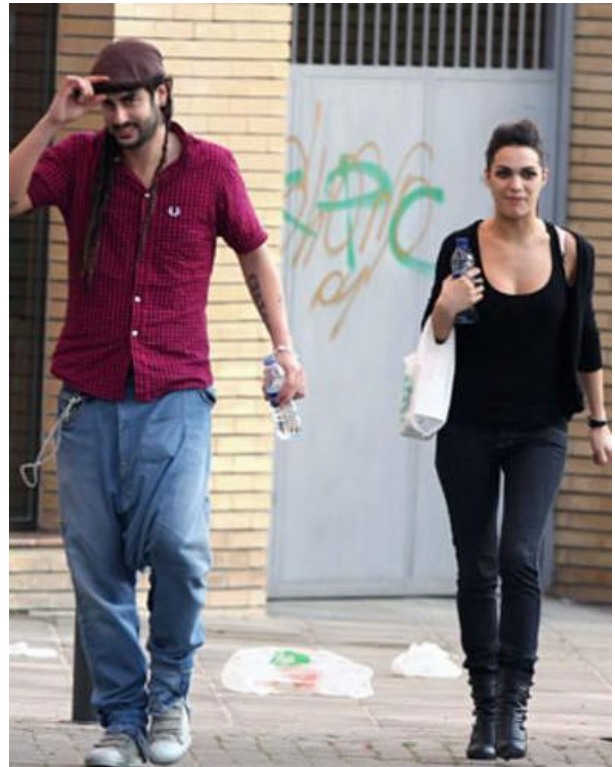
- *Volvamos a empezar*

From 2006 to 2008 Melendi created a foundation called Blue Donkey Music that helps young people that want to start their musical career. In 2006 Melendi participated in a video game called "Gangs of London" like a bad police called Mr.Big. He did the music for this video game. He participated in an ONG with Malú and David de Maria called "Vision Mundi" that helps children who have health problems. On the 12th of November 2007 he was judged because he went to a plane drunk and he began to insult and humiliate the passengers and employees. He has got two children: Carlota and Marco. Carlota is his first child and he had her with his ex-wife Miriam Martinez de la Vega.

Nowadays Melendi is dating with a not very famous singer known as "La Dama". His real name is Isabel and she is younger than Melendi. Melendi met Isabel when they started working together in some songs. Later they fell in love and nowadays they have a child, Marco.

Today, Melendi is considered an idol by many people because they think that Melendi is a good singer and person, and because he helps some people to go through difficult moments.

Melendi's fans club was created in 2006. Nowadays his fans club has got millions of people, and Melendi sometimes gives free tickets to them because of their loyalty. In 2012 he is going to give many concerts .

The suri and the Berhanyer family.

They live in Ethiopia, Africa, in some huts made of branches. They drink milk and they eat meat and cereals which they grow. Men eat first what they want and after that women and children eat what is left over. They like tattooing themselves and wearing rings, bangles and belts. They have a ritual - when they finish the crop, men do a strength fight to decide who is the best. It is called Donga.



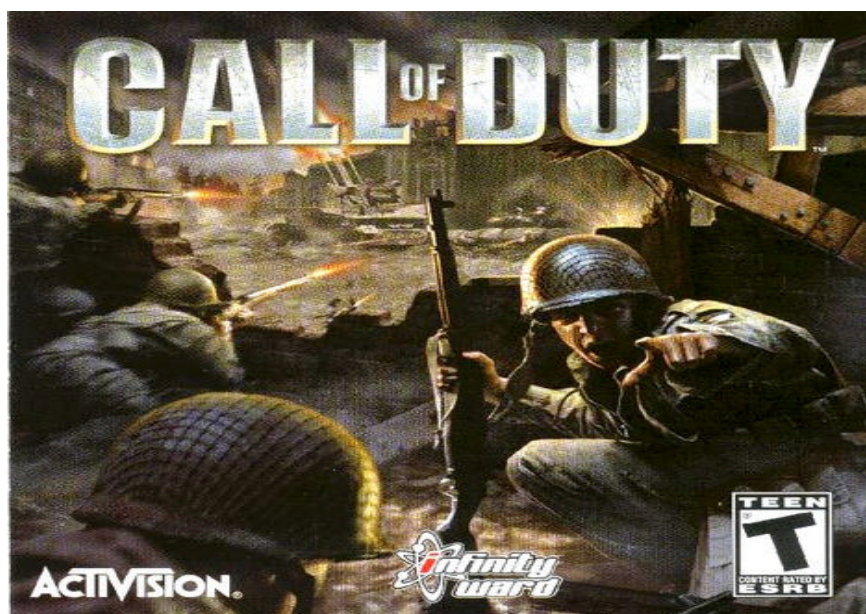
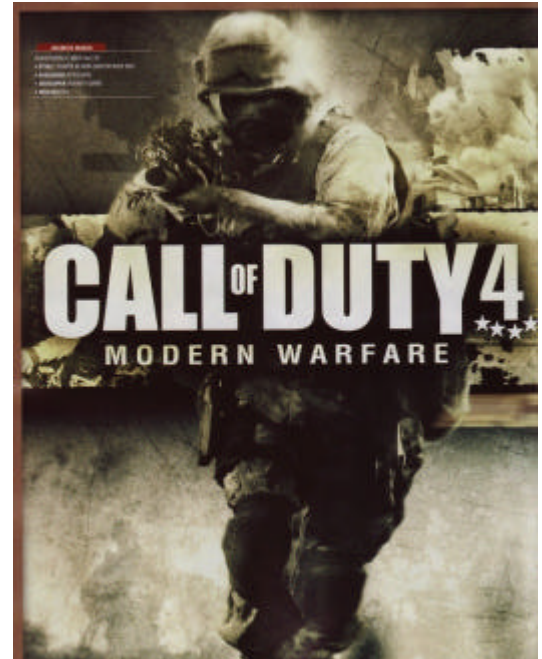

THE "CLASSICAL" MATCH



The Spanish derby, known among journalists as The Classic, is the football match that has been repeated most times between two Spanish clubs. Historically, this "honour" belonged to the fighting between Athletic Club and Real Madrid FC until the beginning of the 2011-12 season.

Currently the most important competition in Spanish football and the football match between clubs is the most seen in the world with about 500 million viewers. It is among the three most important sporting events in the world, only behind the final of the World Cup 2010 in South Africa and the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games, which arrived at 700 and 600 million viewers respectively.

In 2011 thanks to the great display by the public television channel RTVE, the match was seen in more than 140 countries in all continents. Because of the diverse struggles of teams between different competitions (League, Cup and Champions League) , it became the first televised football event between clubs worldwide, reaching what until now was only up to the Olympics and World Cup football.

In December 2000, Real Madrid was named by FIFA the best club in the 20th century worldwide.



THE OLYMPIC GAMES

The Olympic Games are events that are done every four years. This year 2012 they are going to be held in London and people from the entire world are going to go there to enjoy them. Thousands of athletes participate here to win the gold, silver or bronze medals. The sports practised are the following: Athletics, badminton, basketball, handball, boxing, cycling, BMX, swimming, water polo, jumps in the swimming pool, horse riding, fencing, football, gym, rhythmic gymnastics, artistic gymnastics, judo, Greco-Roman fights, fighting, tennis, canoeing, volleyball and a lot more. 186 countries are going to participate in the Olympic Games. The event is going to be held in July, in the main stadium of London. Now approximately 2 months are left for this amazing event to start.



UEFA EUROPEAN FOOTBALL

UEFA European Football Championship is an international football tournament in Europe. Different teams from European countries compete in this tournament to win the trophy of UEFA European Football Championship.

The organization of the first UEFA European Football Championship was difficult to prepare because some of the most important teams in Europe like Italy, Germany and England couldn't participate. The first official match of UEFA was in Moscow, on the 29th of September 1958. In that tournament Russia was the winner.

The matches that are going to be held in UEFA this year are going to take place in the new national stadium of the city of Warsaw, Poland.

This year the following countries are going to participate in UEFA European Football Championship:



- ✚ **Ireland:** This country isn't one of the best teams in Europe but it can be a surprise for everybody in this tournament. They have not won any editions up to now.

- ✚ **Italy:** It is one of the best football teams of the continent, and it has won 4 World Championships and an edition of this tournament.



- ✚ **England:** They have won a World Championship but it hasn't won any edition of this tournament.

- ✚ **France:** They have won a World Championship and 2 editions of this tournament.



- ✚ **Denmark:** They have won the 1992s tournament and it's one of the favourite teams to win this tournament..



- ✚ **Spain:** They have won the tournament twice and it has also won the World Championship in 2010, versus the Netherlands.

- ✚ **Germany:** They have won the incredible number of 6 awards: 3 European tournaments and 3 World Championships too.



- ✚ **Greece:** They have won the tournament in 2004, but they didn't play very well.



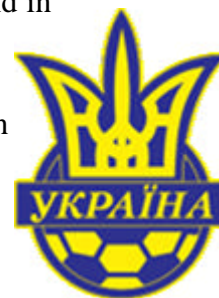
- ✚ **Sweden:** They have not got any awards, so they want to win this year's tournament.

PARROTFISH

The Scaridae is a tropical fish that lives in coral reefs in the red sea, Atlantic Ocean, Indian Ocean and Pacific Ocean.



They are called parrotfish because they have a lot of teeth like parrots. Parrot fishes eat algae, but they aren't herbivore, also eat molluscs.

Adults weigh around 30 kilograms and they are 90 centimetres long.

They are very beautiful because of their bright colours and because they can change their form. They also change the colour when they have different ages. There is lot of species of parrot fishes.

It is very difficult to have them in our houses because they need rocks and corals to eat.

The parrotfish is in danger of extinction because people fish them for eating.

We must be careful with this fish because they are so beautiful.



Strange animals

Over the years people have found lot of strange animals, here are some of them:

Blanket octopus

It's like a cloth crossed with an octopus. They are usually very colourful and relaxed. They are 2 metres long but females are smaller



Shark ray

This fish it's a kind of ray with shark shape, It can be more than 1 metre 80 cm long. Its habitat is around the Pacific Ocean. They are usually blue and grey.



Red panda

It's a kind of panda, smaller and with red colours which lives in forest around China and Nepal. They usually eat weed and plants.



Indian Gharial

This animal is a kind of crocodile with a long snout full of sharp teeth and it uses them to fish.



Water dragon

It is like a seaweed. They always try to be unnoticed, blending with the environment, and changing the colour.



Lurch bull

This bull has very long horns and is a strange evolution of a normal bull. There are only few of them.



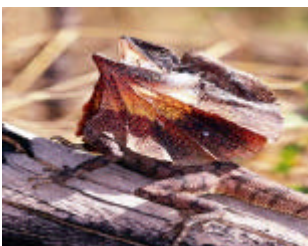
Yellow fairy armadillo

This armadillo is a special kind of armadillo with yellow colour and it has different body than the others.



Frill-necked Lizard

This kind of lizard is very similar to the dinosaur which appears in Jurassic Park. They have red scars and thermoregulation.



COCONUT

CRAW

It is the heaviest terrestrial arthropod in the world. The first pair of legs is armed with large claws, which it uses to break coconuts and it transports objects up to 29 kg.

They eat fruit, especially coconuts and figs. They also eat any organic thing, including leaves, fruit in decomposition, turtle eggs, animal carcasses and their shells, which are believed to provide calcium.

They can't swim, and they drown in water. They use a special body called brachial lung to breathe, which can be defined as a state evolutionary intermediate between gills and lungs.

The crab of the coconut trees lives in burrows or in cracks in the rocks, depending on the type of soil. It digs its own burrows in the sand or soft ground. During the day, the animal remains hidden to protect itself from predators and reduce the loss of moisture caused by the heat.



CURIOUS ANIMALS

There are some interesting animals in the world; here we are going to present some of them.

Platypus

The duck-billed platypus is a species of semi aquatic mammal that lives in the East of Australia and in the island of Tasmania. They are the mammalian current only ones that lay eggs. It is one of the few poisonous mammals, it has a nose with the shape of a duck's beak, a tail of beaver and legs of otter and it appears on the back of the Australian currency of 20 cents.

In general they are brown, they weigh between 700 and 2.400 g and males are bigger than females. Duck-billed platypuses can make a serious growl when somebody bothers them. Until the beginning of the 20th century it was hunted by his skin, but nowadays it is protected.

Star-nosed mole

The star-nosed mole is a small mole found in wet low areas of eastern Canada and the north-eastern United States.

It is covered in thick blackish brown water-repellent fur and it has a long tail.

Adults are 15 to 20 cm long, they weigh 55g and they have 44 teeth. The distinctive character of the group is the presence of 22 pink tentacles at the end of the snout to capture worms, insects and crustaceans.

They eat worms, settles, fly larvae and slugs.



Dolphins

Dolphins are marine mammals. They live in the sea, but they breathe air with an orifice that they have in their head. They are excellent swimmers because they can swim at 45km/h. With the fins they control the direction and they maintain the balance. Dolphins live between 40 and 60 years.

To maintain the temperature, they have got a deep fat layer and their skin is very soft but it heals very fast. They have a good view, they can locate objects inside and outside the water and they can also move one eye in all the directions.

It is curious that dolphins never sleep; they just float and relax their body.

They mainly eat fish, squids and octopus, to catch them dolphins swim around them, and so they can't

escape. They are social animals and they live in groups. These groups have got between 10 and 10000 members depending on their species, so when a shark tries to attack them, they fight in group. To communicate, they use whistles or growls. Dolphins are intelligent and playful, so if they find a human they play with him.



USEFUL BEAUTY TIPS

SPOTS



Everybody has ever had unexpected spots. If you want them to disappear you should clean your skin with special soaps regularly and put specific creams on. If you see that your spots don't go, don't get nervous because in some cases it is because of natural reasons: girls' period for example. You shouldn't eat a lot of chocolate or sweets either. You should eat vegetables and drink a lot of water instead.

WAXING



There are a lot of ways to remove hair, but the best one is waxing because it takes your hair off from the hair root. Your hair will go away for three weeks approximately. After having wax, you should clean your skin carefully.

HEALTHY HAIR IN SUMMER



Now summer time starts and your hair must be perfect because the swimming pool water, sea and sun damage it so much. So here you are some advice to protect your hair from the sun and water.

* Don't use the dryer; you've got summer air which is hot and better than your dryer.

* Use a hair mask that suits your hair to protect it from the sun UVA rays.

* Before summer time starts cut your hair to have it healthy during all the summer and short not to feel hot during sunny months.

FAIRER HAIR



You can use camomile to have fairer hair. It's very easy and anyone can do it. Use more or less 10 tea bags, prepare $\frac{3}{4}$ of litre of camomile tea and let it get a bit cold. Then, add the juice of five lemons and a little bit of oxygen water, put it on your hair, cover your eyes and leave it there for one hour. Then clean it and that's all.

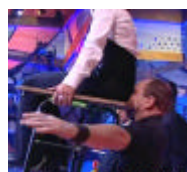


Guinness World Records

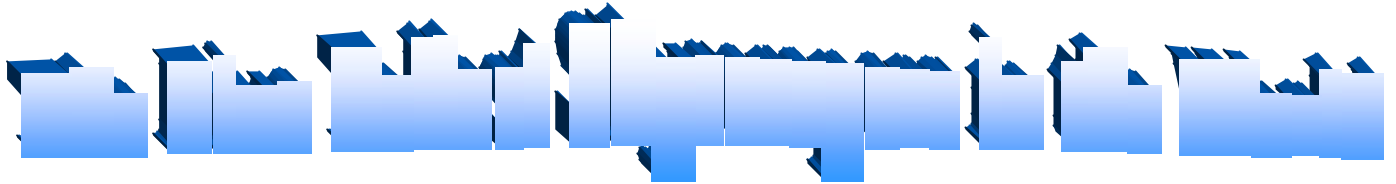

1. BURJ KHALIFA, DUBAI

It is a skyscraper in the city of Dubai, United Arab Emirates, and is the tallest structure built in the world, at 828 meters high. Construction began on September 21, 2004, and was officially inaugurated on January 4, 2010.

This skyscraper is being built in Lower Manhattan, New York. This building had a cost of 2 billion dollars and is going to replace the Twin Towers destroyed by a terrorist attack on September 11, 2001. When it opens in 2013, it will have a height of 541 meters.



3. TAIPEI 101

Taipei 101 is a building that has 106 floors and 101 above ground level located in Taipei (Taiwan). The needle crowns its 509 meters height make it the third tallest skyscraper building in the world

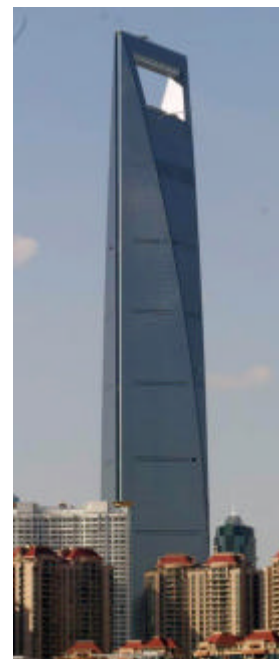
Today is the most prominent building in the world. The Taipei 101 skyscraper horn is considered the safest ever built.

4. SHANGHAI FINANCIAL CENTER

It is a skyscraper in Shanghai, **China**. Its final height is 492 meters and has 101 floors.

5. INTERNATIONAL COMMERCE CENTRE

The International Commerce Centre is a skyscraper in Hong Kong. It has a height of 484 meters and 118 floors. Upon completion of the works became the second tallest building in China, and the fifth in the world. The skyscraper has a luxury hotel chain Ritz-Carlton in the last 15 floors and is the tallest hotel in the world

On internet there are a lot of social nets and the most well known ones are tuenti and facebook.



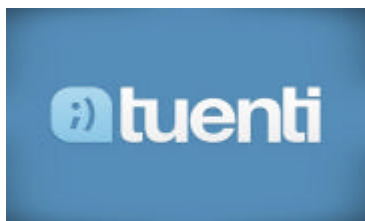
Tuenti

Fire

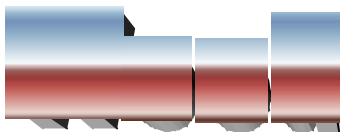
People born in the years of the Fire element are decisive and confident. They are also more aggressive and positive than other natives of their particular signs. They have all the requirements to be winners in life.



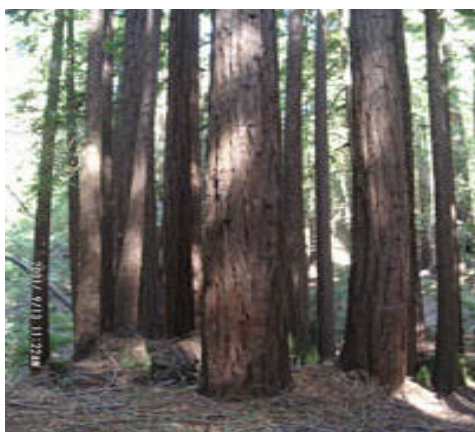
Earth

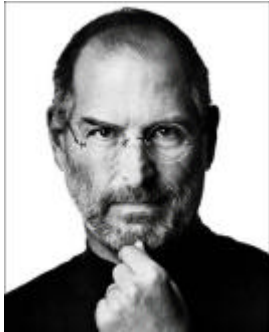

For all these reasons he was given in adoption to Clara and Paul Jobs, who gave him a really nice education and lifestyle. In his child time they moved to Mountain View.

However his real parents got married, in December 1955 and had a second child.

Everything started at Jobs garage when he used to help his father repairing cars. Years later, Steve and two friends of him (Wozniak and Bill), started the revolutionary Apple company, in the same place.

There were 17 towns in the conference in Stockholm to be European Green Capital, 21 of October 2010. Vitoria was selected to be Green Capital in 2012 and Nantes in 2013. The others four finalist were:  Barcelona,  Malmö,  Núremberg y  Reikiavik.
