APASOS is a non-profit association with the aim of protecting animals. Its main objectives are to stop abandoning pets and to avoid the sacrifice. They collaborate with the animal shelter of Vitoria-Gasteiz which annually picks up more than 1500 animals, the majority of them are cats or dogs.

The job of the volunteers is to help these animals that come from the street, because usually they have several injuries or they are victims of mistreatment so they need veterinarian treatment. Once the pets are better they try to find them a temporary house where they can recover calmly until the association gets them a home with all the love they deserve.



The association can't search a temporary house for all of animals which are in the kennel; so they encourage people to give blankets, toys, fodder... like that it will be more comfortable for the pets to

stay there until they have someone who actually care of them.

Not only that, with the purpose of letting more people know about this association and the pets which are searching for a family; they have different social media accounts in which they upload photos and videos of the new abandoned animals and of the different activities they do. Also they share some of the incredible stories of these amazing pets.

During the year, they also organize different campaigns to inform people of the ways they can help. In general, in these campaigns they sell handmade stuff; such as bracelets, book markers, key-rings, etc. Also they sell stuff for pets; like leashes, collars, etc.



APASOS VITORIA-GASTEIZ

APASOS Vitoria-Gasteiz was created in September 2004 by people who believe in the zero sacrifice and thanks to them that has been possible for some years now. The key of this is the collaboration with some associations of Germany because the pets which unfortunately aren't adopted are sent to Germany, due to the fact that there they care more about the animals so they don't usually abandon them.

A recently news about the animal shelter of Vitoria-Gasteiz is the possibility of collecting horses, donkeys and goats. And with the money the council has given them, they will also improve the

Time, are you sure you know what is it ?

Physics is the only science that explicitly studies time, but even physicists agree that time is one of the most difficult properties of our universe to understand. Even in the most modern and complex physical models, time is usually considered to be an ontologically “basic” or primary concept, and not made up of, or dependent on, anything else.

In the sciences generally, time is usually defined by its measurement: it is simply what a clock reads. Physics in particular often requires extreme levels of precision in time measurement, which has led to the requirement that time be considered an infinitely divisible linear continuum, and not quantized. With modern atomic time standards like TAI and UTC and ultra-precise atomic clocks, time can now be measured accurate to about 10–15 seconds, which corresponds to about 1 second error in approximately 30 million years..

But several different conceptions and applications of time have been explored over the centuries in different areas of physics, and we will look at some of these.

In non-relativistic or classical physics, the concept of time generally used is that of absolute time (also called Newtonian time after its most famous proponent), time which is independent of any perceiver, progresses at a consistent pace for everyone everywhere throughout the universe, and is essentially imperceptible and mathematical in nature. This accords with most people’s everyday experience of how time flows.


However, since the advent of relativity in the early 20th Century, relativistic time has become the norm within physics. This takes into account phenomena such as time dilation for fast-moving objects, gravitational time dilation for objects caught in extreme gravitational fields,

and the important idea that time is really just one element of four-dimensional space-time.

Relativity also allows for, at least in theory, the prospect of time travel, and there are several scenarios which allow for the theoretical basis of travel in time. There are even theoretical faster-than-light time-travelling particles like tachyons and neutrinos. However, the concept of time travel also brings with it a number of paradoxes, and its likelihood and physical practicality is questioned by many physicists.

Quantum mechanics revolutionized physics in the first half of the 20th Century and it still represents the most complete and accurate model of the universe we have. Time is perhaps not as central a concept in quantum theory as it is in classical physics, and there is really no such thing as “quantum time” as such. For example, time does not appear to be divided up into discrete quanta as are most other aspects of reality. However, the different interpretations of quantum theory do have some potentially important implications for our understanding of time.

Most physicists agree that time had a beginning, and that it is measured from, and indeed came into being with, The Big Bang some 13.8 billion years ago. Whether, how and when time might end in the future is a more open question, depending on different notions of the ultimate fate of the universe and other mind-bending concepts like the multiverse.

The cathedral of Munich in German Frauenkirche, is one of the biggest gothic buildings of



Germany. The building was destroyed in the WWII, but the two towers of the cathedral made in the XVI century didn't fall because the military use the highest places of the city to know which city was. The most emblematic thing of the cathedral is the Devil's footprint, that as the legend says the Devil left there after the builder lied him.

CLIMATE CHANGE AND ITS EFFECTS ON EARTH


In the last decades, climate in the Earth has changed its weather characteristics at a speed much higher than normal and this change is causing a lot of dangerous effects in our planet. That makes necessary that humans do something and try to stop a process of destruction of the Earth that has already begun.

The problem is that daily human activities are the main cause of the global warming that is causing the current climate change. The population growth on the last 200 years increases energy demand and production, mainly from fossil fuels that has increased the emission of greenhouse gases.

Other causes of the global warming are: deforestation and destruction of marine ecosystems.

The consequence of all this is the increase in the global temperature of the planet which has raised 1.1°C in this period and it is estimated that it could raise by 2.7°C at the end of this century.

The negative effects that scientists had predicted in the past as a consequence of this climate change are now occurring: the disappearance of ice, the accelerated sea level rise, longer and more intense heat waves and the extreme weather events.



All this brings disastrous consequences endangering the Earth's flora and fauna, including human beings.

It's clear that climate change can't be avoided but we must fight to reduce its effects and adapt to its consequences.

It's our last opportunity and it's not an option but a necessity.



Deportivo Alavés, is a football club based in the city of Vitoria. Founded on January 23, 1921 as Sport Friend's Club, has participated in the highest category of Spanish football, the First Division of Spain, since the 2016-17 season, which occupies the thirtieth position in its historical classification.

Its greatest sporting achievement took place in 2001, when, in his debut in European competition, he was runner-up in the UEFA Cup, after losing to Liverpool Football Club by a golden goal in overtime by a 5-4 final.

Identified by its blue and white colors - which receives the name of "albiazul" -, its legal entity is that of a sports limited company (SAD) through the Decree of the Sports Law 10 / 1990, 2 3 to favor the base sports associations, and establish a model of legal and economic responsibility for professional entities. The property is divided between shareholders, the majority owner is the basketball club SaskiBaskonia - personalized in the figure of its maximum shareholder Josean Querejeta -, while the club president is Alfonso Fernández de Trocóniz. He disputes his meetings as a venue in the Mendizorroza stadium, with a capacity of 19,840 spectators, and also has sports facilities in Ibaia dedicated to training.

Its hymn was written by D. Alfredo Donnay, Vitorian musician in the 50s, although it seems that in Mendizorroza was born in the 20s, the famous song of "alabin, alaban ...". In some games in which Deportivo Alavés plays in Mendizorroza, the anthem is sung throughout the stadium starting at minute 21 in honor of the club's founding year.

The Mendizorroza Stadium was opened on April 27, 1924. It is located in Paseo Cervantes, next to the municipal swimming pools and the Estadio Foundation.

Deportivo Alavés has a museum in the lowlands of Mendizorroza that was inaugurated at the beginning of the year 2005. Inside there are trophies like the one of the match against Liverpool in the final UEFA championship in 2001 and a plate in which cataloga to the liking of the Alavés as the best of the year 2001 according to UEFA.



The history of illegal beauty products (XIX-XXI)

Nowadays we all use different types of beauty products and makeup on a daily basis, so could you imagine a time where they were banned? This used to be very common, not only centuries ago, but fairly recently as well. You will be shocked to see the amount of products that are still prohibited!

1860s (The Victorian era)- The Queen Victoria was a trendsetter back then, so women were eager to follow those trends she created, such as wearing no makeup. Beauty products were allowed just for scores.



1910s- At the start of the 20th century, red lipstick was used by suffragettes in the USA to be noticed, so in order to avoid this, the government banned lipstick, claiming it could poison the men kissed by those women wearing it. They also made wearing makeup illegal for women under 44.

1930s- Women started to worry about removing hair during this time, usually using creams containing questionable ingredients such as rat poison (thallium acetate). At that moment long eyelashes started to become popular among women, so they would buy mascaras to lengthen them, the most acclaimed one being Lash Lure. This caused blindness so it was soon removed from the market.

1960s- In 1961, New York made tattooing illegal blaming a Hepatitis B outbreak, which could have had its origins in a number of things other than that.



1970s- Chlorofluorocarbons were used in aerosol sprays, so it was discovered they could cause the ozone layer to deplete. Many women had to change their hair-sprays for this reason.

1990s- Many silicone breast implants were pulled from the market, arguing they could cause leaks which may affect the immune system or cause cancer.

2000s- During this time, lash serums started to gain popularity, the most popular one being Latisse, which claimed to make your natural lashes grow. Many women declared to have seen a change in their eye color, however, is still available in stores to this day.

2010s- Finally, in the present, body and face scrubs have been made illegal, because they can cause harm to the environment and specially to aquatic life. The highly popular brazilian hair straightening treatment has been banned too, due to the high amount of formaldehyde it contained.


ance.

Iker Casillas is a Spanish footballer who plays as goalkeeper in the football Club Oporto of the


first League of Portugal.

Iker Casillas left the CUF Hospital in Oporto on after spending five days in hospital because he had suffered a heart attack while training with his team *Porto Football Club*. The goalkeeper, who left intensive care last, evolved well and two days later left the hospital, as his wife, Sara Carbonero, sport journalist, had reported. According to medical assessments, it will have to rest until September, four months. But *Porto Football Club* are already working to find a new goalkeeper substituting for Casillas.

His former friends from *Real Madrid* gave him a tribute with banners and shirts. Hours later, on his Twitter account, he posted a video thanking all those who over the past few days have supported him.

The Spanish star will have to lead a more relaxed life from now on, at least for the first few days.
